### SUN SAFETY

Don't wait until your child's skin turns red before taking protective action. SunSignals, a company that makes UV Sensors, offers these tips:

- Apply an SPF sunscreen of 30 or more to children, even if you use a 15 SPF for yourself.

- Make sure the sunscreen is waterproof. However, *waterproof* does not mean *all day*; sunscreen must be reapplied regularly and after swimming or toweling dry.
- Make sure the sunscreen is broad spectrum, protecting skin from UVA and UVB rays.
